Decrease the gaps in proficiency rates-by race, EL status, and IEP status--by 25%.






## **Elementary Assessments**

At the elementary level, CRCSD uses two reading assessments.

- 1. FAST: used for the last 5 years; a brief "screener" that indicates if students are reading at benchmark or not
- 2. iReady: new this year for ES; a lengthier "diagnostic" that provides detailed results



## Fall 2020 Results: FAST Reading (ES)








## **Middle School Assessments**

At the middle school level, we are using iReady for reading and math. iReady scores correlate closely to scores on our state test (ISASP) and can be predictive on ISASP.






## Fall 2020 Results: iReady Reading (MS)
