



Supervision Policy

Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian except when under the direct supervision of camp instructors or staff. Children may not be left unattended before camp, during the lunch period, or after camp. Students should be brought to their camp no earlier than 15 minutes before the camp start time and must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after the camp end time.

Age Policy

All camps are for youth ages 8 – 15, unless specified in the descriptions. No younger students will be admitted.




