Saturday, March 19th at 11am

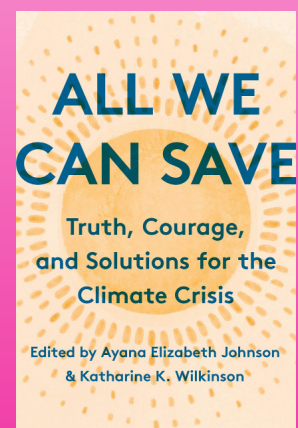
Creating a Greener Period: Looking at Reusable and Sustainable Menstruating Products (In Person)
