AMERICANISM ESSAY CONTEST

Essay Theme: "What is your American Dream?"

- 1. Eligible participants must be a student enrolled in the fifth, sixth, seventh or eighth grade during the normal 2022-23 school year, preceding June 30, 2023. Deadline: Must be submitted to Local Lodge by December 15, 2022.
- 2. Essay length is not to exceed 300 words.
- 3. Essay must be typed or legibly printed in ink. Also, Essay must be submitted as written (or typed) by the entrant.
- 4. Essay must be submitted for judging to the Elks Lodge administering the contest at his or her school or, if unknown, to the Lodge nearest to the home address of the entrant.
- 5. Entrant must be identified on essay by name, home address, grade, school attended and sponsoring Lodge. (Lodge may enter Lodge information on essay cover sheet.)
- 6. Judging criteria:


Originality: Avoid the use of trite or worn out words and phrases -30 points Development of theme: Stay focused on ideas and thoughts. Don't ramble -40 points Mechanics and neatness: Use proper spelling, grammar and punctuation -30 points


There are now four separate divisions for judging essays:

THEME:

"What is your American Dream?"

RULES:

- 1. At the time of the contest, eligible participants must be Students enrolled in one of these four divisions: I—5th grade; II—6th grade; III—7th grade; or IV—8th grade.
- 2. Essay length is not to exceed 300 words.
- 3. Essay must be typed or legibly printed in ink. Also, Essay must be submitted as written (or typed) by the entrant.
- 4. Essay must be submitted for judging to the Elks Lodge nearest to the address of the entrant.
- 5. Participant must be identified by name, grade, school attending and sponsoring Elks Lodge on the Essay.

AWARDS:

Plaques will be awarded by Grand Lodge for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place for national winning essays in Divisions I, II, III, and IV. Monetary awards will be disbursed for each grade level for 1st Place—\$1,000; 2nd Place—\$500; and 3rd Place—\$250. Winners will be announced at the Grand Lodge Session in Minneapolis, MN, July 2-5, 2023.

ENTRY DATE:

Essay should be submitted to local Elks Lodge on/before December 15, 2022. The Essay Contest Cover Sheet must be completed for each level of competition and remain attached to the Essay.

I am pleased to announce that the Grand Lodge Fraternal Committee has selected the theme, "What is your American Dream?" for the 2022-2023 Grand Lodge Americanism Essay Contest. The contest starts with the Local Lodges, progresses through District and State levels, and ends with the naming of our National Winners at the Grand Lodge Session in Minneapolis, MN in July 2023. This contest gives students in four separate grade levels, grades 5-8, the opportunity to thoughtfully, evaluate and express their views on the selected annual theme.

Nationally, first-place, second-place and third-place authors in each division will receive monetary awards of \$1,000, \$500, and \$250 respectfully. Many Lodges, Districts and State Associations also provide various forms of recognition to their respective winners, and the Fraternal Committee appreciates and encourages their extraordinary efforts in support of the contest.

Contest materials including the "annual contest theme" are published on-line on May 1. Lodges are encouraged to communicate with school officials in a timely fashion to facilitate annual curriculum planning.
