PREP YOUR PUMPKINS

- Pumpkins must be gutted (this is Jack SPLAT, not Jack THUD).
- Please remove candles, artificial lighting, or any other decorations that are in or attached to the pumpkin. This includes stickers, ribbons, and remnants of candle wax inside.
- We compost Jack Splat pumpkins. Ones that have been painted or coated with a preserving sealant should not be added to a compost pile. Pumpkins coated with glitter should not be composted.

Pumpkin drop-off will start at 9:15 a.m. in Chauncey Swan Park on November 5th. Please inquire if you have any questions. We reserve the right to reject your pumpkin if it doesn't meet our Jack Splat standards.
