## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

#### You are eligible if you are:

- A person who identifies as a woman
- An incoming freshman through Ph.D. student
- Studying engineering full-time (*exceptions made for re-entry/non-traditional students*)
- Studying at an ABET or Washington Accord accredited program in engineering, technology or computing in the upcoming academic year OR at a SWE Global Affiliate in India
- A community college, university, or re-entry/non-traditional student

### HOW MANY:

In recent years, SWE has awarded students more than **320 scholarships** each year valued at **over \$1.5 million!**

### HOW MUCH:

Individual scholarships range from **\$1,000 to \$20,000**. Many of the scholarships offered are **renewable for 1+ years!**



## BEST PRACTICES FOR APPLYING



**Applications are reviewed based on three main criteria** – academic preparation, extracurricular activities, and future potential success in engineering. Make sure to highlight these areas on your application!



**Double check your program** is ABET accredited before applying

**Complete the correct application** – all applications correlate to your class status as a student.



**Remind your references** to submit their recommendation before the application deadline.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q.** How do I apply for more than one SWE scholarship?

**A.** By completing our general application, applicants will automatically be considered for all SWE scholarships for which they are eligible.

**Q.** Do I need to be a member of SWE to be eligible?

**A.** No, you don't have to be a member of SWE to apply; however, some of the scholarships do require SWE membership.

**Q.** I applied for SWE scholarships in the past and was/was not selected. Can I apply again this year?

**A.** Yes! Previous application cycles do not impact scholarship consideration and students are encouraged to apply each year.

**Q.** When will scholarship decisions be announced?

**A.** Recipients will begin to be notified in early to late summer. All applicants will be notified by September whether they are or are not selected for a scholarship.
