This notice responds to the questions received by the Cedar Rapids Community School District regarding the above bid request.

QUESTION 1	The bid solicitation states to bid Goodyear and Firestone tires ONLY unless notified otherwise. Will other brands be accepted to bid on such as Michelin BFG Goodrich?
ANSWER 1	At this time, Goodyear & Firestone are the only tires that CRCSD will accept other than the two lines indicating the Falken Brand.

QUESTION 2	Is there a way to change the bid to add Michelin?
ANSWER 2	We can discuss this at a later time once the 2024 bid is complete with stakeholders in the CRCSD to discuss changes for future bids.

QUESTION 3	Bid Line #9, should this be a 225/70R 19.5 12 - 14 ply, mud & snow, lug design instead of the 255/70R 19.5 12 - 14 ply, mud & snow, lug design tire?
ANSWER 3	Yes, it should be.
QUESTION 4	Bid Line #12, should this be a 245/55R 17 All Season Tire, instead of a 243/55R 16 All Season tire?
ANSWER 4	Yes, it should be.

QUESTION 5	Bid Line #14. What do you mean by a low grading tire? And is this size correct?
ANSWER 5	We mean Grade E and yes the size is correct.

QUESTION 6	When CRCSD says Grade E, would you like a more inexpensive option for that size or is the district referring to a Load Range E?
ANSWER 6	We are referring to a Load Range E

QUESTION 7	For Line #12, should this tire size actually be 235/55R17 instead of the 245/55R17 as there are only a few manufacturers who make the 245/55R17?
ANSWER 7	We still desire the 245 instead of the 235. However we desire the 245/75R17 All Season Tire instead of the 245/55R17 All Season Tire.
